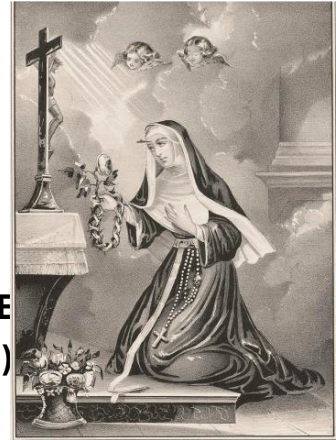

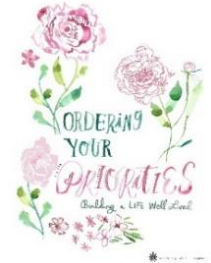

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP The League offers two official categories of membership:

**General** – any Catholic woman 16 years of age or over. Voting privileges and eligibility for office.

**Associate** – any non-Catholic woman 16 years of age or over. Can vote but cannot hold office.

Types of Membership participation:

**Fully Active** – pay dues, attend most meetings & events, take part in business sessions & serve on various committees as available

**Partially Active** – pay dues, attend some meetings or functions, help on a task-by-task basis

**Financially supportive** – pay dues to support the work of the national, provincial, diocesan & parish levels & stay informed through various media

**Prayer partners** – pay dues, take part spiritually in parish spiritual outreach such as Spiritual Bouquets, pray for the work of the League
