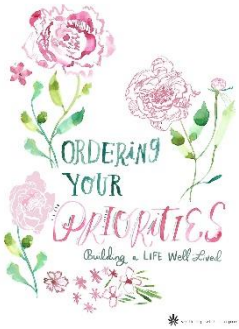

January 7th: St Raymond of Penyafort (1175-1275) Patron Saint of Lawyers

The saint, full of confidence in God, said to his companion, "A king of the earth endeavors to deprive us of the means of retiring; but the King of heaven will supply them." He then walked boldly to the waters, spread his cloak upon them, tied up one corner of it to a staff for a sail, and having made the sign of the cross, stepped upon it without fear, while his timorous companion stood trembling and wondering on the shore. On this new kind of vessel the saint was wafted with such rapidity, that in six hours he reached the harbor of Barcelona, sixty leagues distant from Majorca. Those who saw him arrive in this manner met him with acclamations. But he, gathering up his cloak dry, put it on, stole through the crowd, and entered his monastery.

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

The League offers two official categories of membership:

General – any Catholic woman 16 years of age or over. Voting privileges and eligibility for office.

Associate – any non-Catholic woman 16 years of age or over. Can vote but cannot hold office.

Types of Membership participation:

Fully Active – pay dues, attend most meetings & events, take part in business sessions & serve on various committees as available

Partially Active – pay dues, attend some meetings or functions, help on a task-by-task basis

Financially supportive – pay dues to support the work of the national, provincial, diocesan & parish levels & stay informed through various media

Prayer partners – pay dues, take part spiritually in parish spiritual outreach such as Spiritual Bouquets, pray for the work of the League
